**KAUAI POWWOW  
VENDOR APPLICATION  
September 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup>, & 30<sup>th</sup>, 2012**

The Kauai Powwow Council invites you to share and sell your Native American/Native Hawaiian Arts and Crafts at our 14th annual Intertribal Kauai Powwow. Our objective is to keep our Native American community in touch with their culture, honor our heritage, and share with all, a celebration of music, dance, and crafts with ALOHA, while serving the Kauai community and visitors.

Kauai Powwow 2012 – “Rejuvenate Your Spirit” will be held at the Kapaa Beach Park, in Kapaa, September 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup>, & 30<sup>th</sup>. On Friday, Sept. 28th, set-up for vendors will begin at 12:00 noon, with gates opening to the public at 4:00 p.m. Gates will close at 9:00 p.m. Lights will be provided in each vendor booth. Beginning at 6:00 p.m., the Fry Bread booth will open and we will have a DRUM GATHERING. We will be inviting other cultures on the island to share their drum songs with us. On Saturday, Sept. 29th, vendors can begin set-up at 8:00 a.m. Gates open at 10 am and Grand Entry will begin at 11:00 a.m. We will close Saturday evening about 7:00 p.m. After closing we will host a meal for all dancers, drummers, and vendors. On Sunday, Sept. 30<sup>th</sup>, vendors can set-up at 8:00 a.m. and we will close at about 5:00 p.m. Gates open at 10:00 am and Grand Entry will again be at 11:00 am. Each vendor will be assigned a booth space in order of receipt of paid application (first pay, first choice of location).

Vendors’ goods, merchandise, and or products for sale must reflect the traditions, values and cultural representation of Native American or Native Hawaiian people. All products for resale must be made by **native people** within the USA or Canada. The KPC Board of Directors shall have final approval regarding this requirement.

**VENDOR OPTIONS:**

Craft vendors with items for sale have a 10'x15' covered space with one table and one chair for the three days. The 2012 fee will be sign up before June 1 - fee is \$200; sign up before July 31 - fee is \$225 and sign up on and after **August 1**, fee is \$250.00 for the three days. Booth space for educational information (no sales) is \$100.00 for three days. This is under a covered space with one table and one chair. Extra tables are an additional \$20.00 for the three days. Your booth space should accommodate up to three tables without the need for two spaces. Please indicate additional tables and payment with application.
