VENDOR BOOTH GUIDELINES

The Vendor application with payment of fees and the following regulations will govern admission to and the right to sell during the Kauai Powwow:

1. Crafter booths are assigned on a first come-first served basis. The final assignment of booth spaces will be at the discretion of KPC and may have the right to request crafters to move from assigned areas when necessary for any reason.
2. Vendor booth display shall be confined to an area not to exceed ten feet wide and fifteen feet deep. (10x15ft)
3. It is agreed that each vendor will haul out all empty cartons, boxes and other rubbish from their area at the end of each day. We must return area on loan from the Native Hawaiian Community in good clean condition.
4. Vendors are personally liable for excise, income or any levy relating to their income derived from the Powwow.
5. KPC reserves the right to revoke the privileges of admission and sales at the Powwow of any vendor violation of this agreement. KPC Board of Directors will determine violations. If revoked, fees will not be refunded.
6. There is absolutely NO alcohol or drugs allowed in area nor anyone allowed under the influence of either.
7. NO pets are allowed in vendor's booth or on the grounds of Kapaa Beach Park.
8. Any and all vehicles must be parked facing the ocean and against the fence.
9. Vendors' goods, merchandise, and or products for sale must reflect the traditions, values and cultural representation of Native American or Native Hawaiian people. All products for resale must be made by native people within the USA or Canada. The KPC Board of Directors shall have final approval regarding this requirement.
10. This agreement cannot be changed, altered, modified or otherwise transferred by either party without written consent of parties and shall not be considered a joint venture of partnership between vendors and sponsoring organization.
11. Refund policy is such: Before July 31, 2012: 90% of fee. August 31, 2012: 50% of fee. After September 1, 2012, there will be no refund.
12. Vendors are responsible for their own security of goods. In signing this application form, I do hereby agree to and do indemnify and hold harmless and defend Kauai Powwow Council from and against any and all liability, responsibility, loss, damage, cost of expenses of any kind (including but not limited to cost interest and attorney fees) which KPC may incur, suffer, be put to pay or be required to pay, incident to or arising directly/indirectly from any intentional or negligent act or omission by accident.
